1. Introduction The Kuwait Shooting Federation will organize H. H. The Amir of Kuwait Second International Shooting Grand Prix as per the “ISSF” & “ASC” Rules and Regulations.

2. Events

3. Participation

Participation of shooters is as follows:

- 3-1. Individual: Any number of shooters in each event.
- 3-2. Awarding: Gold, Silver and Bronze medal will be awarded to the Individuals.
Certificates of participation will be awarded to all participants including officials.
- 3-3. Prizes: First – US\$5,000, Second – US\$3,000 and Third – US\$1,000.

4. Entries

Entries are open for Clubs & Federations.

5. Rules and Regulations:

The competition will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations.

Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

6. Protests:

The protest fee is 25€ (KD 9) and appeal fee is 50 € (KD18). If the protest is accepted, the payment will be refunded; otherwise the money will be retained by the Organizers.

Protests and appeals should be in writing, using ISSF Protest Forms (available from the Organizers).

7. Late Entries:

Late entries can only be allowed according to the ISSF rules.

Any Federation reducing the number of shooters/ or officials after the final entry deadline must pay all the applicable fees and costs including the entry fees according to the number of shooters and entries as indicated on the final entry forms originally received by the Organising Committee. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, then no shooter of that Federation may participate in the Championship.

8-1.	10m Range (Indoor)	: 60 lanes of Suis Ascor.
8-2.	50m Range	: 60 lanes of Suis Ascor
8-3.	Final Hall (10m &50 m)	: 10 lanes of Suis Ascor
8-4.	Clay Target Range (Including Final Range)	: 6 fields

12. Guns and Ammunition:

All information about shooters' Guns and Ammunition must be declared and sent not later than 25th January 2013 (Annex 8). Please submit the form fully completed and signed and stamped by the Federation. Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect Forms will be returned, unprocessed. While in Kuwait, all guns and ammunition must be stored in the armoury at the shooting range. Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately should carry a signed and stamped copy of Annex 8 (Details Form for Guns and Ammunition) while both entering and departing Kuwait.

The storage of guns and ammunition in hotels and outside the shooting range is strictly prohibited. The armoury will be open to facilitate the arrival (as previously advised in Annex 4) of official teams until departure.

13. Ceremonies:

Medals' ceremonies will take place daily as indicated in the provisional programme.

All teams must bring one copy of their national anthem (CD) and three national flags (3) (1 x 2 m) and deposit them with the Organizing Committee during the team registration process.

14. Technical Meeting:

The Technical Meeting will take place as follows:

Saturday, 2nd March, 2013

Time: 11:00 Hrs.

Location: Final Hall Range

15. Transportation/Airport:

Participating teams will be met and facilitated on arrival at Kuwait International Airport. Teams will proceed to the visa office (as necessary) and then clear immigration and security controls. Participants will be transported to the Olympic Shooting Range to deposit their guns and then taken to their hotels. Transportation to and from hotels to the Range will be arranged by the Organizing Committee.

A transportation timetable between the hotels and shooting complex will be available in the hotels.

Participating Federations should confirm their departure timetable with the Organizers (Annex 6) at least 48 hours prior to departure from Kuwait.

16. Weather

Temperatures during the period range from 25°C to 15°C. Average sunlight is 10 hours/day. Average humidity is 60%.

You are advised to use high factor sun cream and to cover up during daylight hours. It is advised that you wear a hat and sunglasses while outdoors.

17. Visas

Entry Visas for participants who require them will be issued according to the procedures required by the State of Kuwait Immigration Authorities. Copies of visas will be sent to all participating Federations, who should go to the Visa Office in the airport on arrival to obtain the original copies that are presented to Immigration Control.

18. Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to competitors as scheduled in the Programmed for the Championships in accordance with ISSF Rules and Regulations.

19. Registration and Payments

Registration, confirmation of entries, payments for entries and accommodation fees MUST be made to the Organizing Committee at the Registration Office at the range complex, on arrival. 'Start' numbers will only be issued after all accounts have been fully paid and receipted by the Organizers.

20. Exchange Rates and Local Currency

The currency of Kuwait is the Kuwaiti Dinar (KWD or KD). The exchange rate of the KD to the USD \$ is approximately (3.55USD \$ to 1 KD) in September 2012.

21. Internet facilities

WiFi internet, telephone and fax facilities will be available at the range complex and official hotels.

22. Media Relations

On site media facilities will be available for accredited media personnel. The event will be covered by local and national media.

23. Medical Services

During the competition, the Organizers will provide first aid and paramedic medical cover. A medical doctor will be in attendance during competition hours and on call 24/7.

24. Gunsmith

The Organizers will provide a limited service of gun repair throughout the competition. Gun and equipment manufacturers may also be in attendance.
